REGULATIONS FOR HORSE SECTION

1. Every nomination or entry of a horse to compete at the Show shall be made on the express stipulation and condition that the use of the arena for any purpose whatsoever, shall be entirely at the risk of the owner or trainer of the horse or other person using the arena.
2. **There will be a \$20 Admin and First Aid Fee per rider/handler for entries on Nominate. Gate entry is payable at the ground on Saturday only, \$10 single or \$20 per car, EFTPOS available.**
3. This show is affiliated with Equestrian Australia. Saddle classes and Showjumping classes are conducted under EA rules.
4. EA Rule - Once a horse has competed at a Hack/Saddle Horse or a Show Hunter at its first official competition in a calendar year it must remain as a Hack/Saddle Horse or a Show Hunter for that calendar year.
5. Performance Licences for all registered horses MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR SCRUTINY at all times. The relevant Performance Licence may be scrutinised upon entry into the ring, before presentation of prizes, or at any other time.
6. All mounts in Saddle and Riding Classes to be mares or geldings.
Definition of Novice: All horses (or in the case of Riding Classes, riders which have won any Open Saddle (Rider) Class competing singly at an Agricultural Show or official competition, with the exception of a consolation class are not considered to be novice. Competitors may win three Novice Classes before proceeding to Open Class.
7. **Protests:** A sub-committee elected by the general committee will deal with all complaints and protests. In events held under EA rules, the EA representative present on the day will adjudicate. ***Protests must be made within 30 minutes of the results being announced. All protests are to be made in writing and given to the Secretary before 4.00pm on the day of the Show, with a deposit of \$50 as a guarantee of good faith, but which shall be returned if the protest is upheld.***
8. The committee has the right to refuse any nomination without appeal. Due to the large programme the committee reserves the right to alter or delete any class.
9. HORSE YARDS. A limited number of horse yards are available for Thursday, Friday and Saturday night at \$10 per horse, to be booked on Nominate. Horse yards must be left clean.
10. CAMPING: Camping sites must be booked on nominate at a cost of \$15 per night (powered or unpowered).
11. Removal of horse manure and feed is expected of all competitors
12. DOGS MUST BE ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES.
13. NO DOGS or PRAMS in competition, practice or warm up areas.
NO SITTING on the ground in shared laneways or arenas.
Please ensure the safety of your children whilst in proximity of horses.

Sandra Southwell

Sandra was born into a horsey family and spent her childhood attending pony club and local shows as well as breaking in and re-educating ponies. As Sandra got older the family would travel the show circuit competing at Brisbane, Sydney, Melbourne and Adelaide Royals as well as major agricultural shows.

In about 1974, Sandra with her mother Iris and brother Shane brought a team of show horses to Tasmania. As many people do, they fell in love with our state and decided to move here permanently.

Throughout the 1980's and 1990's, Sandra dominated both Hack and Riding classes in Tasmania with horses such as Tarantella, Anna Karenina (Anna K) and the enigmatic Christopher Robin.

Sandra ignited a passion for horses and riding in many children through her residential riding camps. Not a one trick pony, Sandra was also proficient at riding side-saddle, driving harness horses, stock work etc.

Her tragic death in a light plane crash in 2018 was devastating for her many friends and so to honour her contribution to the equestrian community a decision was made to introduce the class **“The Sandra Southwell Memorial Lady Rider.”**
