RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Age of beef cattle to date from 1st March.
- 2. Bulls over 1 year old to be rung by the nose and shown in halter and nose lead. Cows and heifers to be shown in halter, nose clip and lead. All cattle to be tied up by halter and neck strap.
- 3. All cattle are to be tractable. Any animal not deemed as such will be removed from judging ring at the discretion of the judge.
- 4. All cattle must be registered with their respective societies.
- 5. Chief cattle steward reserves the right to split classes or combine classes depending on numbers.
- 6. A minimum of three (3) exhibits is required for a breed to have their own breed classes, any breeds that have less than three exhibits will be entered in to the any other breed class
- 7. Spot washing of cattle only and blowers/generators to be turned off by 9am for judging they may be used again at the lunch break.
- 8. All straw to be clean out of stalls prior to leaving (\$50 per stall if left uncleaned)
- 9. All cattle to be in their pens at 8.30 am for NILS Scanning please supply your vendor dec via email this is a requirement.
- 10. All studs will be required to supply at least one volunteer to assist with ring stewarding, marshalling and/or MC duties on the day. A roster will be completed and distributed prior to the day, and every care will be taken to ensure that everyone has adequate time to prepare their cattle and teams for showing. No volunteer, no show!
